Subject: AFMA Electricity Derivatives Turnover Report

AFMA has released the <u>AFMA Electricity Derivatives Turnover Report</u>, which provides annual turnover data for the exchange and over-the-counter (OTC) electricity derivatives markets for 2017/2018 and earlier years.

The Report may be of interest to market participants and other observers of the market.

Data in the Report for OTC transactions, which constitute the bulk of the data reported, was compiled from a survey of the principal participants in the OTC electricity derivatives market. ASX Limited provided the data on exchange trade turnover of derivatives. The methodology adopted in compiling the data is presented in the Report.
