



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING AFMA'S DIPLOMA OF FINANCIAL MARKETS

Upon completion of AFMA's Financial Markets Program students are awarded the *FNS51015 Diploma of Financial Markets*.

AFMA has been advised by the vocational sector regulator (ASQA) that the current *FNS51015 Diploma of Financial Markets* has been superseded by the new Financial Services Training Package. **This means that AFMA's RTO cannot issue qualifications for *FNS51015 Diploma of Financial Markets* after 30 June 2021.** Following that date, AFMA can no longer issue this qualification.

Implications for current students

Students currently enrolled in *FNS51015 - Diploma of Financial Markets*, have until **31 May 2021**, or their program expiry date (whichever comes first) to complete the Diploma in its entirety.

Implications for prospective students

Students intending to enrol in *FNS51015 - Diploma of Financial Markets*, in the near future will have until **31 May 2021**, or their program expiry date (whichever comes first) to complete the Diploma in its entirety.

Implications for AFMA accreditation – transition arrangements

AFMA will introduce alternative education arrangements for Accreditation purposes and related details will be announced in the near future.

If staff of AFMA member firms are undertaking Diploma studies to achieve [AFMA Accreditation](#), and are unable to complete their studies by **31 May 2021**, AFMA will have in place transition arrangements to ensure they have clear pathways to achieve their accreditation goal.
