**Subject: Correction to AFMA's Electricity Conventions**

AFMA Members and market participants are advised that AFMA has amended the Electricity Conventions to correct references to changes to AEMO's settlement calendar resulting from the Shortening the Settlement Cycle rule change.

AEMO is moving from 20 NEM Business Day settlement to 9 NEM Business Days. In the previous version of the conventions clause 5.2 incorrectly indicated this would occur in a single move on 9 August 2026. This version has been corrected to reflect that the change will occur in stages between 9 August and 11 October. Timings for each week during the transition period are listed in Appendix A to the conventions.
